In July of 2022, Open Roads is curating a six-day river rafting adventure for high school women that is focused on demystifying the college essay writing process, while also providing time with college-age mentors who have been exactly where you are.

In addition to the growth that comes from group travel in nature, we hope participants will leave with an outline and a grounded sense of the stories they want to tell in their college essay, as well as an increased confidence in your ability to navigate the transition to college, and beyond.

The heart of the trip is a four-day river rafting trip through the majestic Gates of Lodore Canyon, on Utah's Green River-- one of our country's most awe-inspiring wilderness areas. The trip will use the unique opportunity that river

travel offers as a time to decompress, to reflect on our values, and to share stories of how to make the most of this pivotal time in life with others who have traveled a similar path.

Too often, the high school years are marked by stress and anxiety about the transition to college. Our belief is that by bringing together college students and high school students in an immersive and inspiring environment, we can bring a sense of calm about the road ahead, and maybe even bring back some of the magic to this wonderful rite of passage. The trip will also be a thrilling and fun journey with a combination of exhilarating rapids, peaceful flatwater, hikes to waterfalls and native rock art, camping under the stars, ample time for play, and so much more.
